



Dear Parishioners and Friends of Rosary Cathedral:

Our regional area of Northwest Ohio and Southeastern Michigan was hit by two devastating storm waves last weekend. What makes the aftermath of such a violent natural disaster tragic is the loss of life and home. Five people died in this tragedy and many people lost all they owned in a matter of minutes and seconds. The reality of this occurrence is made all the more present to us when it happens so very close to our own homes.

News reporters give their on-site perspective to an event such as this and most of the time they, like us, must wonder why tragedies like this happen. I like to think that when natural disasters strike our livelihood it is a matter of calling all of us to a greater appreciation of the precious gift of life given to us. Most of the interviews of TV reporters with those who were victimized by the recent storms put a visual perspective in mind for me. After losing everything they owned and standing in front of their home that at one time housed family collectables, heirloom treasures and of course, many memories, these persons often express thanks for their personal safety and for the lives of their family members. In those moments when our personal effects can be violently taken from us, we have no other recourse but to consider the gift of life that has been given to us.

We certainly keep all of those families that are now in the process of rebuilding their lives in our deepest thoughts. We pray for those whose loved ones were taken in death and now feel tremendous loss and sorrow. Various regional agencies like the Red Cross and other church sponsored groups in the local areas that were hit by the storms are providing support to those victimized by this tragedy. Monetary donations can be directed to them.

READINGS FOR TODAY

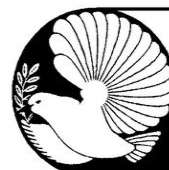
In the First Reading, 2 Samuel 12:7-10, 13

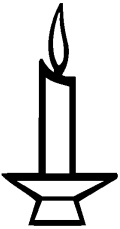

PARISH REGISTRATION:

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 12 noon, 2 pm and 6pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-3:30 pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

HOSPITAL VISITATION:

When admitted to an area hospital, parishioners should contact the Parish Office in order to receive a pastoral visit, the Sacrament of the Sick or Holy Communion.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION:

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the Bishop's Daily Mass Chapel every First Friday of the Month following daily 7 am Mass until 12 noon October to June.
