A prophet sees a brighter future for the people. God will provide the grace needed for repentance.

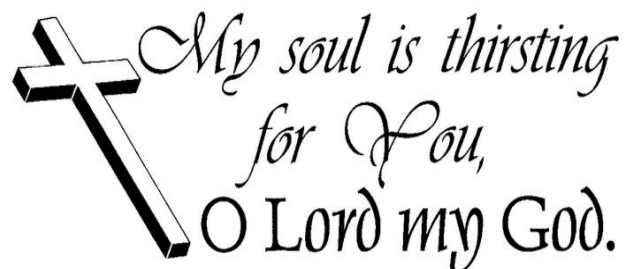
In the Second Reading, Galatians 3:26-29

The Sisters of St. Francis of Sylvania will be showing a one-hour documentary about Sisters who were imprisoned in Eastern Europe from the end of World War II to the fall of the Berlin Wall in 1989 for openly practicing their faith. Join us at **this Friday, June 25, 2010, at 7PM** in the Franciscan Theatre and Conference Center of Lourdes College on the grounds of the Sylvania Franciscans. Admission is free.

Interrupted Lives: Catholic Sisters Under European Communism was written and produced by Sylvania Franciscan Sister Judy Zielinski. Almost 60 Sisters were interviewed in cities ranging from Warsaw, Poland and Budapest, Hungary to Bratislava, Slovakia; Bucharest, Romania and L'viv, Ukraine who told what it was like to live through this "concentration convent" era. Additional filming was done in the Toledo area using Sylvania Franciscan Sisters as actors. Many parishioners of the Toledo diocese are first or second generation immigrants from these countries and may find this film personally touching. Sister Judy will be at the showing on June 25 to talk about how the film was produced, what it means to her as a Catholic nun and why it is so important to tell this little know story.

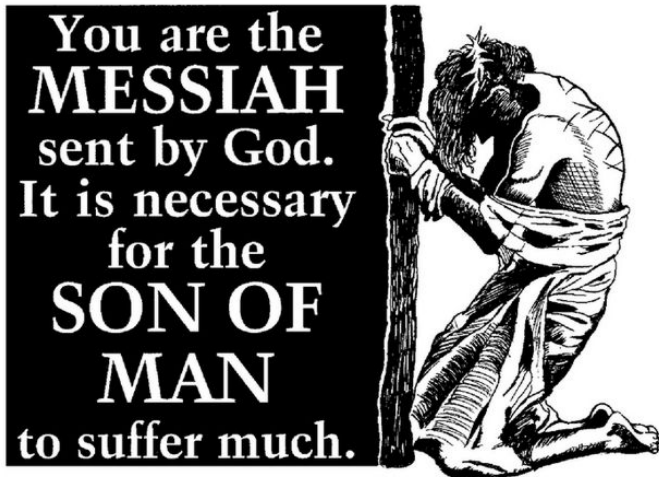

PARISH REGISTRATION:

Please notify the Parish Office at 419-244-9575 when you have a telephone number and/or address change so we can keep our records current. New members are always welcome and can register in person or by calling the Parish Office.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 12 noon, 2 pm and 6pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-3:30 pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

HOSPITAL VISITATION:

When admitted to an area hospital, parishioners should contact the Parish Office in order to receive a pastoral visit, the Sacrament of the Sick or Holy Communion.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION:

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the Bishop's Daily Mass Chapel every First Friday of the Month following daily 7 am Mass until 12 noon October to June.
