

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Rosary Cathedral:

The season of summer, especially during the month of July, gives me the opportunity to pull back from the normal schedule of events on our campus and reflect on the activities that our parish has experienced during the course of the past fiscal year. We just completed the 2009-2010 fiscal year on June 30 and will soon begin the preparation of our annual state of the parish and finance report for all of our registered households.

One significant concern for me this past year has been our parish finances. Some months ago, I shared with all of you in my weekly bulletin column some of the shortfall that we have been monitoring for our weekly offertory contributions (the monies we thought would be generated). I am happy to report that while that budgeted forecast experienced a shortfall this past year, we were able to make some of the other reductions in expenditures balance to the point that we will likely reflect a financial gain for our year-end report to the Bishop. This is great news.

As we began the 2010-2011 fiscal year on July 1, the thought immediately came to mind that we will again need to monitor closely our finances. I am not certain what more can be stricken from our parish budget this next year since much of the "pork" has gone to "lean", or as I have heard some say "bare bones". What will be required is your continued support of the parish in the weekly and holiday collections. These collections pay our bills and provide the livelihood for hard working parish employees.

I've noticed that our Sunday collections have been down the past weekends. While I am certain that the hot and humid weather has contributed greatly to a number who have difficulty attending Mass in non air-conditioned facilities, or that many of our members may be vacationing or traveling during the summer weekends, I hope that our members would see that their Sunday offertory contribution for the weekends that they are away from the parish are placed in the collection basket either before or after their absence from the parish during the summer.

There are so many good things that have taken place on our Cathedral campus and we could not provide many of those services without your financial support and prayers. Thank you for your generous support of Rosary Cathedral Parish. May these days of summer provide you with opportunities to renew your spirit.

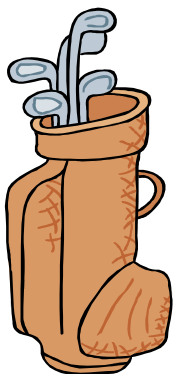

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 12 noon, 2 pm and 6pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple **MUST** be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-3:30 pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

HOSPITAL VISITATION:

When admitted to an area hospital, parishioners should contact the Parish Office in order to receive a pastoral visit, the Sacrament of the Sick or Holy Communion.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION:

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the Bishop's Daily Mass Chapel every First Friday of the Month following daily 7 am Mass until 12 noon October to June.
