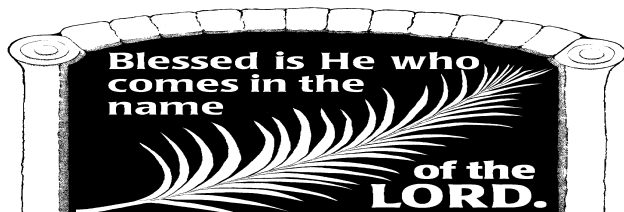

HOLY WEEK ART EXHIBIT AT ROSARY CATHEDRAL

For several weeks I have been announcing that Rosary Cathedral will host a Holy Week art exhibit in the main corridor of the Parish Activities Center featuring the work of Toledo artist Frank Murphy. This exhibit has been titled: "Christ of Today: A Paschal Triduum Exhibit" and is open to the public during the selected days and hours indicated below. Mr. Murphy has prepared six framed pieces depicting the events leading to our Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. Each rendering captures the tension existing between acts that repress human life and the redemptive hope that rises from the Jesus we encounter in our world today. I believe you will find these renderings most touching and liberating.

Frank Murphy works within the studio setting at the Collingwood Arts Center and has exhibited his work in the local Toledo area. Prints of his exhibited work will be available for purchase during and after the Holy Week Exhibit.
