

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Rosary Cathedral:

I am pleased to announce this weekend that the outreach ministry provided by the Cathedral conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society will resume its operation this next week. Due to security concerns relative to our school facilities this past winter, the outreach services provided by the faithful Vincentians of our parish were suspended temporarily until a new location on our campus could be prepared. The St. Vincent de Paul outreach ministry at Rosary Cathedral is now located at the Parkwood entrance of Msgr. Smith Auditorium. Upon entering the glass doors and left of the vestibule entrance is a newly created room that was formerly used by the Cathedral Credit Union. Until recently, this area was used to store school and parish supplies. This location will provide a public access, yet maintain security for the rest of our school facilities and those who study and work within our walls.

The new outreach center area features a state of the art security system and ample space for food storage and consultation area to converse with clients. I wish to thank our Operation/ Finance Manager, Mr. Tom Peters, and parish maintenance staff members Mike and Dan Szymanski for the expenditure of their time and hard work in creating this new location for our Vincentians.

Many have been asking about our pending parking lot expansion project. To date, it is my understanding that the parking lot project is to commence at the end of May. I ask for your patience and understanding as we move into these capital improvement projects. All of us will obviously be challenged in seen and unseen ways by these projects, so please understand that the circumstance is not intentional to make life hard or miserable for anyone, but a means to improve the great gift this campus has been and will be for the future.

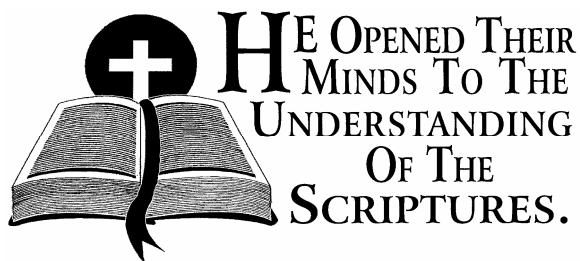

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:**

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:**

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 10am, 12 noon, and 2pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

**SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:**

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-4pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.
