

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Rosary Cathedral:

I am pleased to inform you this weekend that Rosary Cathedral recently received a civic recognition for the development of our campus in the Old West End. At a social gathering held in downtown Toledo on May 16, the Landmarks Preservation Council recognized Rosary Cathedral with a **Historic Preservation Award**. The distinction expresses that the award is granted *“for the site development along Collingwood Boulevard that complements the architecture of the Cathedral located in the Old West End district”*.

Toledo City Council also offered its recognition with a written resolution on this occasion. A portion of this resolution reads *“Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral has recently developed a parking lot for its congregation; drawing on the architectural heritage of the Old West End; the fence and landscaping complement this historic district...be it resolved by the Council of the City of Toledo that Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral is honored and recognized for contributing to the continued protection, preservation and appreciation of the historical beauty within Northwest Ohio.”* I am very grateful to all who made this distinction possible and the positive outcome of our parking lot facilities this past year.

I am announcing this weekend the fact that with this new parking lot installation, we have had need to create a new entrance from the South side of our school facilities. We are presently seeking the necessary approvals with diocesan and civic officials to begin the installation of a handicapped-accessible entrance from the new parking lot facilities. This new entrance will include a foyer with connecting doorways to the first floor kitchen, gymnasium and stage area, and two newly installed restrooms. Construction will hopefully begin at the end of the present school year.

As family and friends gather together for this first holiday weekend of the summer season, we remember with great gratitude the valor of women and men in our armed forces who made the supreme sacrifice of their lives for the freedom of others. May this 2007 Memorial Day weekend find peace emerging in the areas of the world where it is wanting, and may the dead, whose memory remains close to the heart of a grateful nation, live in eternal peace.

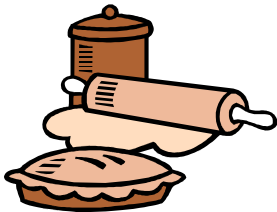

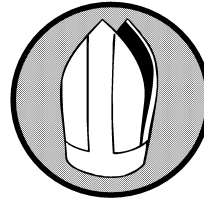
