

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Rosary Cathedral:

During the month of March this year, I announced to the parish that Fr. Marvin Borger would be moving to Rosary Cathedral to make his residence here and offer to assist me with the sacramental ministry of the parish. Since that announcement, pastoral necessity has prompted a slight alteration to that arrangement. While he will continue to live with Bishop Blair, Bishop Ottenweller, Fr. Boff and myself at the Episcopal Residence, his sacramental service to our parish will now be limited to weekday morning Masses only as of July 1, 2007. In addition to his appointment as Chancellor and Vicar General of the diocese, Fr. Borger recently received the added appointment of serving as a part-time associate pastor of St. Rose Parish in Perrysburg. Essentially, this means that he will provide ministerial service to the people of St. Rose on weekends. We congratulate him on this added appointment and wish him well. I am still grateful that he will avail himself to serve us for occasional weekday Masses at Rosary Cathedral.

This weekend marks the 23rd anniversary of my priestly ordination. I consider it a great privilege to serve as a priest of the Diocese of Toledo and even more so in service at our diocesan Cathedral parish. As I recollect the experiences I have had as a priest the past 23 years, each of them provides a unique encounter with God's people. Considering all of the past assignments and opportunities each of those venues offered to enrich my life, I would not trade any of them. God has been good to me and as I offer the great prayer of our church this weekend, you, the members of our parish and the mission we are undertaking together at Rosary Cathedral, will be close to my heart. Thank you for all you do to make Rosary Cathedral the place that it is.

Finally, as we enter into the summer season, I would like to congratulate all of our high school and college graduates from Rosary Cathedral Parish. In particular, I would like to acknowledge senior graduates Zachary Wilfaert (Central Catholic) and Katie Nelson (Cardinal Stritch). May God bless you for your past academic studies and guide you to a future of great promise and prosperity.

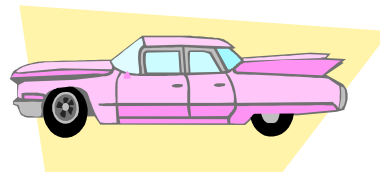


St. Adalbert Parish is sponsoring Our Lady of Fatima Devotions every month beginning in May through October. All are welcome.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 10am, 12 noon, and 2pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-4pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

HOSPITAL VISITATION:

When admitted to an area hospital, parishioners should contact the Parish Office in order to receive a pastoral visit, the Sacrament of the Sick, or Holy Communion.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION – Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the Bishop's Daily Mass Chapel every First Friday of the Month following daily 7am Mass until 12 noon.
