Mission awareness and the support given by Catholics world-wide to the regions of the globe are at the heart of the faith we profess. Jesus' public ministry was consistently outward in orientation. His mission was to seek the lost and to fulfill the longing deeply felt in the soul of those who sought the truth.

It is hard to imagine that a developed world which has been so successful in technological advancements must still be reminded of the places where many aspects of life and faith are wanting, if not entirely absent. They do exist. Mission awareness and the annual Propagation of the Faith Appeal offer us the opportunity to know the needs of others in the world. Our prayers and financial support to this cause will make a difference and continue to Church's effort to evangelize souls to Christ.

Special contribution envelopes will be made available in the pews next weekend. Thank you in advance for your generous response to this annual collection.

While I am expressing gratitude for your generosity to this effort next weekend, I would also like to bring the parish membership up to date on our Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) campaign for 2007. As of June 27, Rosary Cathedral Parish has pledged \$21,178.00 in funds to the 2007 ACA. Our diocesan goal for this year was set at \$10,867.72. This is wonderful!

As of June 20, Rosary Cathedral Parish was listed as one of eight parishes that successfully reached their designated goal for the 2007 appeal. Still, a significant amount of pledges are needed to reach the total diocesan goal of \$3.3 million. To date \$1,556,449.57 has been pledged toward the diocesan goal.

If you have not yet made a contribution to the 2007 Annual Catholic Appeal I hope you might consider a gift pledge toward this diocesan-wide effort. Our diocesan offices and agencies depend on these annual funds to provide support for many needed services in local parishes and ministries sponsored by the diocese. No gift is too small. PARISH REGISTRATION:

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 10am, 12 noon, and 2pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-4pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

HOSPITAL VISITATION:

When admitted to an area hospital, parishioners should contact the Parish Office in order to receive a pastoral visit, the Sacrament of the Sick, or Holy Communion.

EUCHARISTIC ADORATION – Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the Bishop's Daily Mass Chapel every First Friday of the Month following daily 7am Mass until 12 noon.
