Jesus commissions his disciples to dress like itinerant preachers. They are to carry on his ministry of calling to repentance, exorcism and healing.

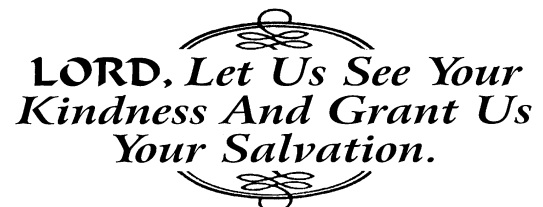

Health Information from the Parish Nurse Ministry:

Bicycle Safety: Do not push your child to ride a 2-wheeled bike until he or she is ready., at about age 5 or 6. Consider how coordinated they are, and their desire to learn to ride. Stick with coaster (foot) brakes until your child is older and more experienced before switching them to hand brakes. Take your child with you when you shop for the bike, so that they can try it out. It's better to make sure the bike fits, than it is to surprise them with one that doesn't. Helmets should be worn by people of all ages on bikes, no matter how long your ride will be. When purchasing a helmet, look for a label or sticker that says the helmet meets safety standards. A helmet can protect your child from serious injury, and wearing one all the time will help them develop a good habit. PARISH REGISTRATION:

Please notify the Parish Office at 419-244-9575 when you have a telephone number and/or address change so we can keep our records current. New members are always welcome and can register in person or by calling the Parish Office.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 10am, 12 noon, and 2pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-4pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

HOSPITAL VISITATION:

When admitted to an area hospital, parishioners should contact the Parish Office in order to receive a pastoral visit, the Sacrament of the Sick, or Holy Communion.
