

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Rosary Cathedral:

This weekend we welcome Father Freddie Decal, pastor of Holy Family Catholic Church in Dulac, LA, to Rosary Cathedral. He is here to provide us with a first-hand account of the devastation wrought by the hurricanes that hit the southern gulf coast late last summer and early fall, and the effects these natural disasters have had on the members of Holy Family Parish in their efforts to rebuild. We, the members of Rosary Cathedral Parish, will connect our prayers and support of Father Decal and his parishioners by way of a special collection this weekend. Registered households in our community should have received a letter from me last week explaining this parish-wide effort along with an enclosed envelope to accept your financial contribution. These special envelopes may be mailed to us directly to the parish office or placed in the Sunday collection basket.

For those who are visiting us at Rosary Cathedral this weekend, or members who did not receive the parish-wide mailing last week, additional envelopes are provided at the ends of the pews. You may need time to think and pray about the financial gift you are able to make. Simply mail the contribution envelope to us at the Cathedral or place it in the Sunday collection basket next weekend. We will see to it that your contribution to the people of Holy Family Parish is forwarded to Father Decal directly.

Fully aware of the financial constraints that many people experience these summer months, I wish to express my sincere gratitude for your willingness to help other Christian believers, members of our faith, in their efforts to rebuild that which was lost to a natural disaster. We pray for our friends at Holy Family Parish that their faith is restored and that those parish effects that were lost will bring about a renewed strength and resolve. It is a noble thing we are doing. God loves the cheerful giver!

Finally, I am announcing this weekend that Rosary Cathedral Parish will be honoring Bishop Robert Donnelly for his 20+ years of service to the parish (and diocese) on Saturday, August 26, 2006. Bishop Donnelly will preside at the normally scheduled 4:30 PM Mass on Saturday, August 26, followed by a cook-out supper for the entire parish. Please mark your calendars now for this parish event to honor and thank Bishop Donnelly.

Health Information from the Parish Nurse Ministry:

Lawn Mower Safety: Try to use a mower with a control that stops the mower from moving forward if the handle is let go. Children younger than 16 years should not be allowed to use ride-on mowers. Children younger than 12 years should not use walk-behind mower. Make sure that sturdy shoes (not sandals or sneakers) are worn while mowing. Prevent injuries from flying objects, such as stones or toys, by picking up objects from the lawn before mowing. Have anyone who uses a mower wear hearing and eye protection. The mower should never be pulled backward or any mowing be done in reverse unless absolutely necessary, and certainly look for children before this is done. Always turn off the mower and wait for the blades to stop completely before removing the grass catcher, or crossing gravel paths, roads, or other areas. Do not allow children to rise as passengers on ride-on mowers. SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 10am, 12 noon, and 2pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-4pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.

HOSPITAL VISITATION:

When admitted to an area hospital, parishioners should contact the Parish Office in order to receive a pastoral visit, the Sacrament of the Sick, or Holy Communion.

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION:

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament is held in the Bishop's Daily Mass Chapel every First Friday of the Month following daily 7am Mass until 12 noon.
