

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Rosary Cathedral:

Several weeks ago, I indicated in my weekly bulletin column a new effort at Rosary Cathedral to bring our members 50 years old and over together for a monthly gathering at the parish. We are calling the group the **Cathedral Gold Club**. Since so much of our present interaction with one another is only at Sunday Mass, a funeral Mass or luncheon and a few social events throughout the calendar year, it seems fitting to designate a day each month when our golden-aged members can gather for lunch, to visit, or engage in some social activity together.

A few of our parishioners have met with me to coordinate this effort. Another possibility that could eventually emerge from the monthly luncheon might include short day trips, where a chartered bus would take the group to a specific civic or religious site. A day-trip might include a venture to Frankenmuth, MI for a chicken dinner and a visit at Bronner's Christmas Wonderland, or a visit to the Sorrowful Mother Shrine in Bellevue, OH for a prayerful day-retreat with lunch, or a jaunt on the Ohio/Indiana Turnpike to the University of Notre Dame to see the Basilica of the Sacred Heart and famed Grotto of the Blessed Mother on campus. The possibilities are many. I suspect there are many others that could be considered.

The purpose of the **Cathedral Gold Club** is social in nature with the intent of promoting the life and membership of our Cathedral Parish. Too often, parishes in this day and age can become complacent. While we cannot claim the number of members like our Toledo suburban parishes, we are still a community. There is a spiritual and interactive life on the campus at Rosary Cathedral and we want to nurture and promote that aspect of our community.

I am excited about the **Cathedral Gold Club**. I think it will provide another opportunity for members to be together on a monthly basis. For those members of the parish who are 50 years old and over, I hope you will plan to join us for the first luncheon gathering in September. The date is Thursday, September 20, 2007. We will meet in the Parish Activities Center (first floor level of the parish office corridor) at 12 NOON until 2:00 PM. There is no charge for this first luncheon. Feel free to bring a friend or neighbor. Reservations must be called in to the Parish Office by Wednesday, September 19, 2007. Look for more details in future Sunday bulletins.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

Baptisms are celebrated at Rosary Cathedral on the third Sundays of the month at 12:15 p.m. Parents of first-born children are required to attend a one-hour preparation conference before the baptism. Call the parish office at 419-244-9575 for more information and to register for the conference.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE:

Marriages at Rosary Cathedral are celebrated on Fridays at 5pm or 6pm, Saturdays at 10am, 12 noon, and 2pm. Engaged couples should contact the parish office a minimum of six months in advance in order to complete the necessary preparation. At least one member of the couple MUST be in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION:

Confessions are heard each Saturday from 3-4pm in the Cathedral. Communal Reconciliation services are also held during the seasons of Advent and Lent.
